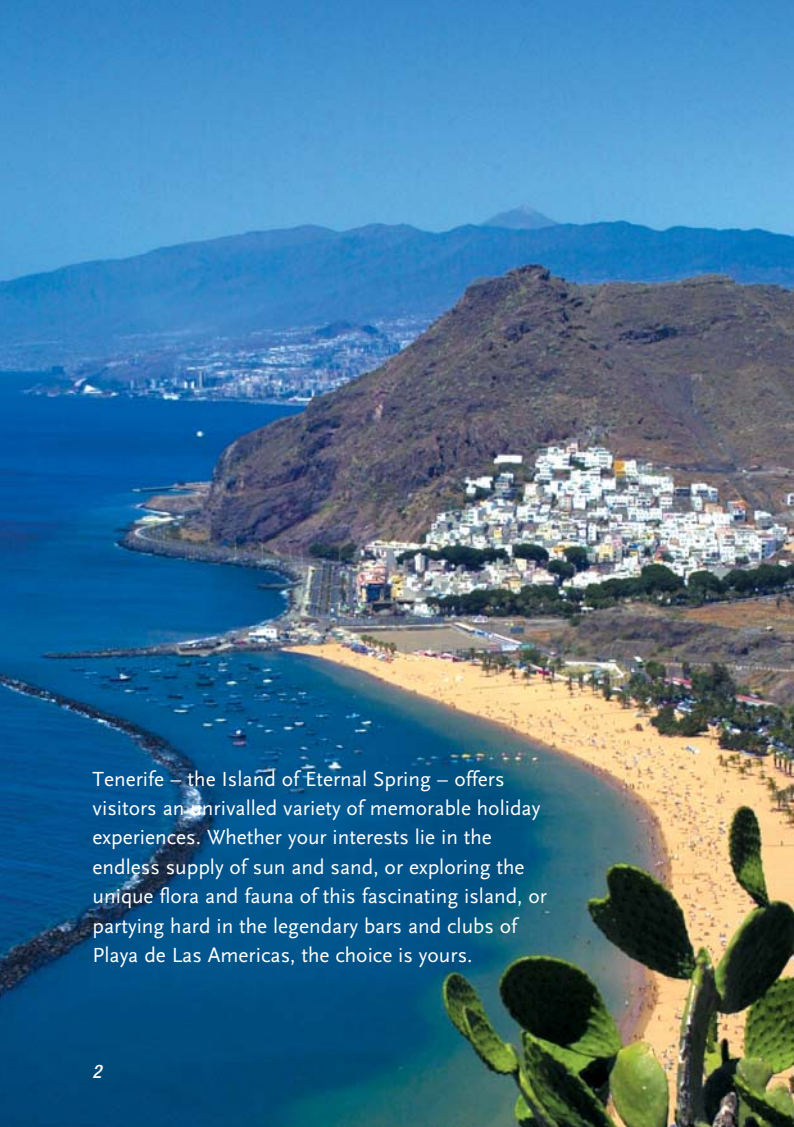

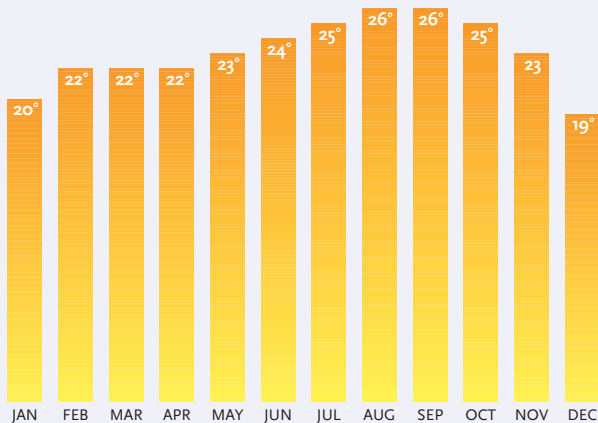

# Weather and climate

Tenerife enjoys one of the world's best and most diverse climates, of the kind normally found only on huge continents. All year round, the fresh and humid Trade Winds that waft over the Canary Islands keep the temperatures down to an agreeable level. Tenerife features the lowest temperature difference between summer and winter for anywhere in the world – from 26° in summer to 19° in winter.

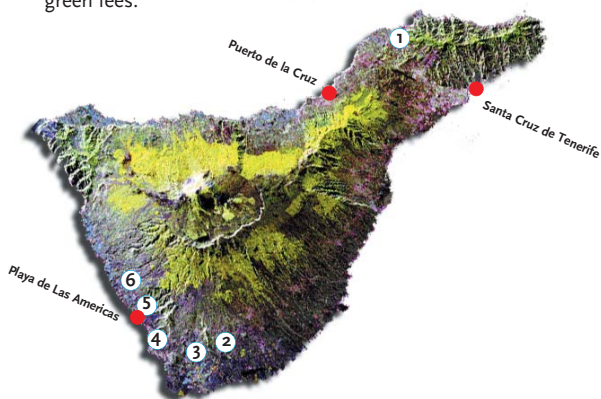
For such a small island, Tenerife offers a surprising variety of weather zones, enabling the inhabitants to “choose” their climate depending on where they live. The great altitude of Mount Teide means that it can experience snow for up to three months of the year, yet it's still possible to enjoy a swim on the beach less than an hour's ride away.





# Golf

There are now six courses in Tenerife, all situated within easy driving distance of the Club La Costa resorts. In fact, one of the resorts actually looks over the 27-hole championship Golf del Sur course. Ask Reception for details on how to book and possible discounts on green fees.

# Getting around

## Airport transfers

All the Club La Costa resorts are within 20 minutes drive of Reina Sofia airport. You will find taxis immediately outside the airport, although if you prefer, Club La Costa will pre-book an airport transfer for you. Ask about this service at the time of confirming your reservation (and remember to have your flight details to hand). Your return journey can also be pre-booked through Reception.

## Car rental

Car hire is available through our resort car-hire companies at very competitive prices. You can collect your reserved car at the airport or, if you prefer, at the resort. Please ask your Holiday Coordinator for a quote.

## Bus service

A bus service runs between the resorts and the main towns. The services operate every day except Friday, and tickets can be purchased from Reception and cost between €3 and €12. Please see Reception for details of times and services.



## Resorts and facilities

### **Sunningdale Village**

The accommodation in this beautifully located resort is set in lush tropical gardens. This is a resort, which truly offers something to please everyone, including a large free-form swimming pool, children's pool and playground. Other sports such as golf, tennis, water sports, fishing and horse riding can easily be arranged by Reception on request.

### **Club La Costa Monterey**

This established resort, nestling on a hillside on Tenerife's southern coast, offers a spacious swimming pool, baby pool and Jacuzzi for relaxing after a hot day on the beach. The resort and accommodation are constantly being improved and upgraded in order to maintain the highest of standards. There are plenty of on-site activities for guests to enjoy, including squash, table tennis and pool, plus a Fitness Centre where guests can keep in trim before hitting the town to indulge in the vibrant nightlife on offer.

### **Club La Costa Paradise**

Also conveniently located on the sun-kissed southeast coast of the island, this resort boasts two swimming pools, plus a baby pool and Jacuzzi. As with Monterey, the resort and accommodation are continually being improved and upgraded in order to maintain the highest of standards. Again, there is plenty to do; on-site activities include badminton, Crazy Golf and even Giant Chess close to the pool area.

### **Sam's Pantry**

All Club La Costa Resorts in Tenerife have a Sam's Pantry where you can do all your essential shopping, including freshly baked bread, dairy products, frozen goods, newspapers and souvenirs.

# Restaurants and bars

## Sunningdale Village

Relax outside on the terrace, in the restaurant, or sip a cool cocktail in the bar. Zacary's Restaurant & Cocktail Bar is situated next to the swimming pool and offers food throughout the day – continental and traditional English breakfasts, snacks, barbeques and an à la carte menu. By night the restaurant creates a buzzing atmosphere with nightly entertainment.

## Club La Costa Monterey

Enjoy the superb views at the Sunrise Bar & Restaurant, which offers a choice of hearty or light snacks throughout the day. Sunset is the newest addition at Monterey, where guests can sample fine cuisine from international to local recipes.



## Club La Costa Paradise

Zacary's restaurant & Cocktail Bar located around the main pool area, offers a wide selection of dishes throughout the day. In the evenings it becomes an à la carte restaurant with live music. Murphy's Law has regular evening activities, followed by some of the best entertainment acts in Tenerife.



## Places to visit

### Teide National Park

This National Park includes an enormous volcanic crater 48km in circumference, out of which rises the highest mountain in Spain, Mount Teide. Access to the now extinct volcano is either by foot or by a cable car, which will carry you almost to the summit. From the peak, on a clear day, you will have breathtaking views of Gran Canaria, La Palma, La Gomera and El Hierro.

### Siam Park

Come and experience Siam Park, the biggest water park in Europe, with some of the greatest attractions in the world! With its amazing Wave Palace, where waves reach 3 meters in height, the longest Lazy River, the Tower of Power and many more fantastic features... When you need time to catch your breath there is also a huge inland beach and numerous chill out bars and catering facilities.

### Loro Park

Regardless of your age, you will be fascinated by Loro Park. Originally a Parrot Park, it has now grown into Tenerife's second biggest attraction and is home to over 300 species of parrot, an amazing sea-lion and dolphin show, aquarium and shark tunnel, gorillas, chimpanzees, tigers, jaguars, flamingos, alligators, tortoises, an orchid house, a Gambian market, a "NaturaVision" cinema and the world's largest penguinarium – complete with a reproduction Antarctic climate.



## Los Gigantes

The “Giant Cliffs” are remarkably sheer rock walls that plunge into the ocean a quarter of the way down the west coast of Tenerife. Massive cliffs drop into the sea from a height of 500-800m in some places. Across the bay lies the little port and resort town of Los Gigantes and Puerto de Santiago. The only way for you to get closer to these amazing cliffs is by boat.

## Aquapark

This Aquapark, situated near Los Cristianos and Playa de Las Americas, is a fun day out for all the family. The park boasts a dolphin show, children’s area and an amazing variety of water rides and slides, pools, sunbed areas, restaurants and shops. A free shuttle bus service leaves both Los Cristianos and Playa de Las Americas every day.

## Boat Excursions

Tenerife offers a large variety of boat trips on catamarans, motor and sailing boats. Search for whales and dolphins, whilst topping up your tan. Pilot whales reside just off the coast of Playa de Las Americas year round. Fancy some water sports? There are boat trips to secluded coves which include the usage of water sports equipment for your leisure! Deep sea, big game fishing boat trips are available too! From short budget trips, to all inclusive luxury chartered yachts with skipper, everyone is sure to enjoy a great sailing day!

# Tenerife towns

## La Laguna

Tenerife's second city, La Laguna, is the old capital of the island and is situated just inland from Santa Cruz. It is still the cultural and religious capital due to the fact that it is home to San Fernando University and the Bishop's Palace. The city is full of outstanding architectural monuments, palaces and traditional houses of the 17th and 18th centuries. Among its many religious buildings are the impressive Cathedral, Santo Domingo Church and the Church of Nuestra Señora de la Concepcion.

## La Orotava

The Villa de la Orotava lies on banana plantations. This old town distinguishes itself by its magnificent and monumental structures and its well-shaded patios and squares. The historic town centre is definitely worth a visit, in particular for its botanical garden, "La Higuera del Botánico", with more than 3,000 tropical and subtropical plant species from South America, Africa and Australia. La Orotava also has three beautiful dark-sand beaches, all usually free of crowds.

## Santa Cruz

Santa Cruz is both the administrative centre and the capital of Tenerife. Located on the north-east coast, it is a bustling city and one of the busiest shipping ports in the whole of Spain (and the deepest in the world). Situated in a large natural bay, it has a stunning backdrop of mountains over 1,000 metres high. Although the city lacks the sightseeing attractions of La Laguna and La Orotava, it does provide excellent opportunities for retail therapy!



## Los Cristianos

Los Cristianos is one of the most popular resorts on the Canary Islands, enjoying year-round sunshine. The artificial beaches are among the best on the island and it has a small harbour that offers fishing trips, pleasure cruises, glass-bottom boats, diving excursions and ferries to La Gomera. While Los Cristianos retains some of its original architecture and atmosphere as a quaint fishing village, it also provides a vast array of pubs, clubs, shops and restaurants as well as a boisterous nightlife.

## Playa de Las Americas

Playa de Las Americas is a tourist mecca built in the late 1960s and neighbours Los Cristianos and Costa Adeje. Virtually free of anything Canarian, it became the place for Northern Europeans to come and party, with row upon row of British pubs, fish-and-chip shops and pizza parlours. This is a home from home for anyone who wants to spend their nights in the coolest hot spots and their days on the beach sleeping it off. For sun and fun this is a paradise for the young, or those brave enough to try it!

## Puerto de la Cruz

To the north lies Puerto de la Cruz, popular with holidaymakers for 100 years. Modern architecture and a cosmopolitan atmosphere mix with the charm of the original fishing village, international hotels sit alongside a proliferation of bars and restaurants offering exciting nightlife, while colourful street artists perform in picturesque plazas. Black, volcanic sand beaches are compensated by the "Lago de Martianez"; an open-air seawater pool. Other attractions include the superb Botanical Gardens and 'Loro Parque', with spectacular animals and shows.

# Frequently asked questions

## Do we need to bring our own towels and linen?

No. All towels, including pool towels and linen are provided. Pool towels can be changed at Reception for €1.50 per towel.

## Is maid service included?

Yes, maid service is included. Please contact Reception for a current housekeeping schedule.

## Do we have to pay the electricity bill?

No, there is no charge for electricity.

## Can we stay another night?

Although additional nights cannot be booked in advance during peak season, our Reception staff will be happy to check availability when you arrive.

## Where will we be accommodated?

All accommodation for promotional stays is at a Club La Costa resort. Whilst we cannot guarantee a specific apartment or resort (we have to provide first choice to our members) every effort will be made to give you your choice. You will be notified of your resort at least 14 days before your departure.

## How will we get from the airport to the resort?

Bus transfers can be arranged. To book these, please notify us of your flight number and arrival time. This can be booked during your confirmation call.

## Are the children's activities free?

The Mini Club is for children aged between 4 and 12 years. All activities can be arranged through Team Marina and are free of charge.

## Do all the apartments have kitchens?

Yes, and most units also feature washing machines and microwave ovens.
